

Partnership between the P10 and Wageningen University's Rural Sociology Chair






- Main actors in the LL: collaborating rural municipalities (P10) + Wageningen University and Research Centre

- Highlights of the report:
 - Municipal basic services concerns are increasingly differentiating across villages and social groups
 - Lots of data and indicators, but often with insufficient granularity and/or explainatory power for (sub-) municipal policy making
 - Combining and matching <u>formal</u> with <u>informal</u> datasourcing turns out to be key in <u>municipal</u> policy making processes
